

# ***NYS OUTDOOR PISTOL CHAMPIONSHIP SUPPLEMENT***

## **Excellence in Competition (EIC "Hardball") Match**

- WHEN:** September 18 & 19, 2010  
To be held in conjunction with NRA/NYSRPA NY State Championship
- WHERE:** 8081 Greenbush Road, Town of Newstead New York (Erie County)
- SPONSOR:** Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP)
- ELIGIBILITY:** Anyone may compete.
- AWARDS:** DCM "Distinguished Badge" awarded to competitors who attain 30 points in Distinguished Revolver competition. Credit points awarded to highest scoring 10-percent of all non-distinguished competitors firing in a given competition. To the highest 1/6th of qualifying 10-percent, 10 points will be awarded; to the next highest 1/3rd of the qualifying 10-percent, 8 points will be awarded; to the remaining competitors in the qualifying 10-percent, 6 points will be awarded.

**COURSE OF FIRE:** NRA National Match course:

10 shots slow fire at B6 50-yard target in one 10 minute block.  
10 shots timed fire at B8 25-yard target in two 5-shot 20 second strings.  
10 shots rapid fire at B8 25-yard target in two 5-shot, 10 second strings.

- ELIGIBLE GUNS:** All pistols must comply with the following specific requirements: (1) Standard stock of wood or synthetic material or a similar stock of commercial manufacture that retains the "as -issued" profile and that does not interfere with the functional or maintenance features of the pistol. Metal grips and Pachmayr- style wrap-around grips are not permitted. The stock must be functionally identical for right or left-hand use; (2) Trigger pull of at least 4 pounds; (3) Open sights only with a non-adjustable front sight. The rear sight may be adjustable and must have an open "U" or rectangular notch. Competitors may use any of the following U. S. service pistols in the National Trophy Pistol Matches and CMP sanctioned EIC Matches: (A) U.S. Pistol, Caliber .45, M1911 or M1911A1 or (B) U.S. Pistol, 9mm, M9 or Beretta 92F type or (C) U.S. Pistol, Caliber 9mm, M11 or Sig-Sauer P226. In each instance the pistol must be a pistol that was issued by the U.S. Armed Forces or a commercial pistol of the same type and caliber. The pistol must also comply with the following specific requirements.
