- DATES:** Sunday, June 13, 2010 and Sunday, August 8, 2010 (two separate matches)
- LOCATION:** 8081 Greenbush Road, Town of Newstead, New York (Erie County).

- SPONSOR:** Ten-X Shooting Club, Inc.. Our range has thirty 50-yApril 24, 2010ard firing points with pneumatically turned, electronically timed targets at 25 yards.
- RULES:** NRA Pistol Rules will apply throughout.
- ELIGIBILITY:** This is an Approved Tournament; open to all. NRA membership is strongly encouraged, but not required. Entry is limited only to range capacity of 30 shooters per day.
- CLASSIFICATION:** NRA classifications will be used. Proof of classification must be furnished (NRA Temporary Score Record Books are acceptable proof). Unclassified competitors will fire in the Master class.
- ENTRIES:** Complete and return the attached entry form, along with check or money order payable to TEN-X SHOOTING CLUB, INC., for the entry fee.

- ENTRIES CLOSE:** Entries should be received by the Friday prior to the match in order to guaranty berthing. Post-dated entries and show-up entries are be permitted to range capacity. A \$2.00 post-date surcharge will be assessed to show-up entries.
- TEAM ENTRIES:** Four person teams as per NRA rules. Firing members to be chosen prior to the start of .22 Caliber Slow Fire match.

ENTRY FEES: INDIVIDUAL MATCHES:

- 1 Gun:.....\$30.00 (Matches 1-5)
- 2 Gun:.....\$35.00 (Matches 1-5,7-11)
- 3 Gun:.....\$40.00 (Matches 1-5,7-11,13-17)
- 1 GUN SCORE ONLY.....\$25.00 (MATCHES 1-5)**
- 3 GUN SCORE ONLY.....\$35.00 (MATCHES 1-17)**

Fees include minimum registration (\$10) and NRA fee (\$ 4.50)

TEAM MATCHES:

3 Gun:.....\$ 8.00 (Match 20 -- NOT Fired) per team, or \$2.00 per person.

CLASSES:

The regular NRA Classification System will be used (High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, and Marksman). Unclassified competitors and competitors without proof of classification will fire in the Master Class. A minimum of five (5) competitors is required to constitute a class and a minimum of five (5) is required for a separate category within a class.

The combining of classes and/or categories will follow the NRA guidelines and established club rules.

CHALLENGES:

Allowed according to NRA rules with \$1.00 charge per challenge.

FINAL BULLETIN:

Sponsor will mail final match bulletin to all competitors.

SAFETY:

Competitors must furnish and wear their own eye and ear protection.

LUNCH:

Our kitchen will be open to serve a light lunch.

AWARDS:

Awards are provided by the sponsor and will be given in cash or NRA points. Please indicate your preference on your entry form.

There will be open and class/category awards with open winners ineligible for class awards. We will use the updated StatOffice8.0 auto calculations to determine amount and number of awards . There will be a first place in each class and category. A second place requires 8 or more shooters in a given category or classification. A Third place requires 13 or more shooters in a given classification or category. If there are less than five (5) competitors in a given class or category, it will be combined with the next higher class, except that if there are fewer than five (5) High Masters, High Masters will fire for open awards only and Masters will not be combined with High Masters.

CONSOLIDATION:

We reserve the right to delete relays due to lack of entries.

SCHEDULE:

The relay begins at 0900 hours. Competitors should arrive no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the match to sign in and register.
