If it happens a second time, they will lose their membership. This has been a long standing policy. Please respect it – as a matter of safety and courtesy to your fellow members.

Club members interested in fielding a team in the WNY Sporter Rifle League, the Suburban Pistol League or the WNY Smallbore Rifle League are encouraged to start discussing the idea.
