We will post a notice on the website when it opens. The combination will likely be changing this season, so we will keep you posted.

If the score posted is different from what you wrote down before you left the range, it is probably due to a math error on the scorecard.
- Clarence Shooting Club has a potential solution to address the splash-back issue at the indoor range. If anyone has any other solutions that could address the issue please make sure to mention them at the general meeting on May 3rd.
- Ed has brought to the club's attention that the Make-a-Wish Foundation has decided that it will not sponsor any more wishes involving firearms. The Elma Conservation Club has taken up the mantle, and we might give a club donation to assist this endeavor. It will be discussed at the meeting.
- We have received word from the Genesee Conservation League that due to the range roof collapse and the partial collapse of the range's outer cinder block wall, the May 15 (2011) pistol tournament (1800 match) is cancelled. Therefore, GCL will not be hosting any 1800 Indoor matches until further notice.
- Once again, we are finding jacketed rounds in the range. **Jacketed bullets of any type are not allowed in the indoor range.** This includes hollow-points. This includes "plated" bullets. The only exception is copper-washed lead bullets. How do you know it is copper-washed? The plating will be thin enough that you can still indent the bullet with your thumbnail or the edge of a casing. If you see someone using jacketed rounds, remind them of this rule and inform club officers as soon as possible.
- Come shoot with us, Thursdays 7:00 pm until ??, at the indoor range, and starting Thursday, April 28, 2011, we will be at the outdoor range, weather permitting.
