

A little about Ten X

Our indoor facilities (Located at 853 Ransom Road, Lancaster NY 14086) consist of an indoor 20-position fifty foot (50') target range for handgun and smallbore (.22 rimfire) rifles. Center fire handguns are permitted, but jacketed and/or high velocity ammunition is strictly forbidden from the indoor range. In other words, lead reloads indoors only. Target carriers are pneumatically turned and electronically timed for consistent match conditions. We offer 24-hour card controlled access to the indoor facility to members in good standing.

Our indoor range building also has a meeting/classroom area, well suitable for class instruction, or qualification courses. Please inquire for more information.

Open Shooting Program

(ages nine and up)

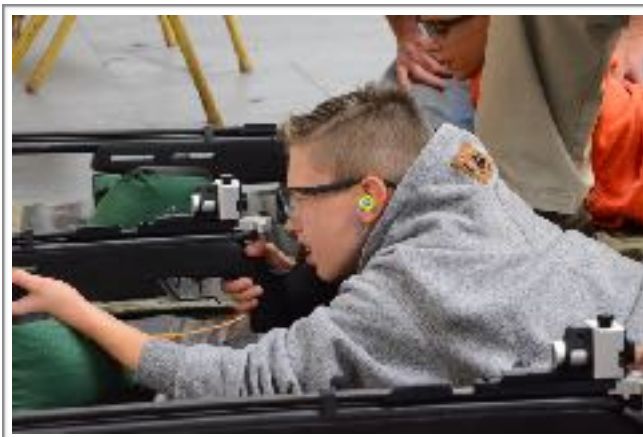
- Open to youngsters ages nine and above
 - All ages nine and above may shoot air rifles
 - Ages twelve and above may also shoot small bore / .22 LR rifles
- Rifles are provided, along with safety equipment
 - Shooters may bring their own firearms (subject to examination and approval by the range officer)
- Instructors are all experienced shooters with many having 20, 20 or 40 or more years of shooting experience. Several of our instructors are also National Rifle Association certified rifle instructors and/or Coaches
- All first-time shooters are required to go through an initial safety and equipment instruction session prior to going on the range
- We shoot from September through May at our indoor range in the town of Lancaster, and we hold special shooting days in the summer at our outdoor range in the town of Newstead

Smallbore Competitive Shooting

Our club has multiple National Rifle Association certified rifle instructors as well as NRA and 4H certified coaches. Also, our President, Peter Vasilion, formerly coached the Clarence High School Rifle Team and is committed to promoting this opportunity for your students. We have invested thousands of dollars in architectural and engineering studies to modernize our indoor range, with a new HVAC system in the coming year. We were awarded multi-thousand dollar NRA Foundation grants in each of the past two years for the express purpose of starting a Smallbore program.

We are inviting high school rifle team shooters to participate in our youth rifle program. As our program is not affiliated with any school, shooters will need to provide their own ammunition and firearms, or bring school owned target rifles and equipment. Alternatively, we have three Anschutz 1903 target rifles and five new Ruger American rifles that would be available, as well as shooting mats, scopes and stands. We also provide targets for our 50-foot indoor range, and our 50-and 100-yard outdoor range.



About The Program

Our program runs on the second and fourth Friday of every month (September through second Friday in May) from 7:30pm to approximately 8pm, at our indoor facility, located at 853 Ransom Rd in Lancaster. Exceptions to this schedule are the Friday after Thanksgiving and the Friday before Christmas when there will be no program. We also open our outdoor facility (located in the town of Newstead) for special summer sessions. Times/Dates of these sessions can be found on our website, under the Youth Shooting section. In the event of inclement weather, we follow the Lancaster Central School closing policy — if school or after-school activities are cancelled on a shooting day, our program is also cancelled for that day. As well, if there are any travel advisories issued for the area in and around our range, shooting will be cancelled.

Fee Schedule

There is a very modest \$3.00 range fee to cover consumables. Membership in the Ten X Shooting Club is not required by participants or their parents/guardians, although we encourage parents to join and become active in our adult program for their own enjoyment! Range fees may be waived in the event of hardship—no child will be refused to participate on account of cost. Parents are required to remain on-site while the youth are shooting (no “drop-offs” please). Parents/Guardians who have experience in the shooting sports are encouraged to assist in the program as we are always looking for any help we can get to keep the program running smoothly.
