

**PROPOSED:
An Amendment to the
Ten X Shooting Club, Inc.,
Constitution.**

At the April 2021 General Membership meeting, M. Martzolf made a motion to amend the Club Constitution to create a new membership category. This motion was seconded by M. Giansante and the motion passed unanimously.

The proposal to the Membership is to create a new class of Junior Members. This class would be open to any youth ages 13 to 21 for the express purpose of joining one or more of the Ten X Shooting Club sponsored competition teams. There would be no requirement that the prospective Junior Team Member's parent or guardian be a member of Ten X. If adopted, the New Clause would be inserted as Clause 3 of Article 3, Membership, and the existing Clause 3 would be renumbered to be Clause 4.

The difference between a Junior Member and a Junior Team Member is this: a regular Junior member can use the club **anytime**, as long as they are supervised by a responsible member and they pay the ordinary range fee. **Junior Team Member would be restricted to team activities only and can only shoot under the supervision of the sponsoring team's coach or captain.**

The proposed New Clause:

ARTICLE III
MEMBERSHIP

[...]

3. Any citizen 13 to 21 years of age may become a Junior Team member of this organization on a vote of the Board of Directors, on unanimous approval of members present, and on payment of the usual initiation fees and dues set for Junior Team members. Junior Team members shall not enjoy range privileges outside of organized Team activities, shall not enjoy the power of voice or vote, and cannot hold office in this organization.

Per Article X of the constitution, this will be presented at the May 3, 2021 and June 7, 2021 meetings and voted on twice, once at each meeting. If you cannot attend these meetings, you may submit a proxy vote for one, but not both of these meetings.
